Beacon Health Options (Beacon) serves as Maryland's Administrative Services Organization to help manage the State's Public Behavioral Health System (PBHS). Beacon assists in the management of the PBHS by providing a variety of administrative and clinically-based services. These services include: utilization management, care coordination, customer service, claims payment, reporting, data analysis, provider relations, training, promotion of recovery-oriented care, expansion of best practices, member advocacy, and peer recovery support.

Beacon supports providers, mental health and substance use disorder advocates, and local authorities (Core Service Agencies and Local Addiction Authorities) through care management activities, quality initiatives, claims payment, and technical assistance to respond to the behavioral health needs of the members we serve. We ensure that the 1.3 million Medicaid recipients and those eligible uninsured recipients who access behavioral health care receive appropriate and timely treatment.
